# Subject: Minutes of Meeting of the eDistrict MMP National Rollout Project held on 13<sup>th</sup>May 2014 via Video Conferencing with the States/UTs

- 1. A meeting was held on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2014 to discuss the implementation of eDistrict MMP National Rollout Project with the states/UTs. The meeting was conducted through Video conferencing from 2:30 pm in the Conference Room, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Electronics Niketan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Sh. Rajiv Gauba, Additional Secretary (eGov), DeitY. The list of officials who participated in the meeting is placed at Annexure A.
- 2. Additional Secretary welcomed all participants. Sh. Gaurav Dwivedi presented the current implementation status of states/UTs. The key decisions and actions to be taken are listed below:

	Selection of SI	DeitY expressed concern on the delay in the SI selection. State team informed that a single bid has been submitted and conveyed that SI finalization would be completed in a month's time. The delay is primarily due to Assembly and Lok Sabha elections.	
		DeitY conveyed that in case the State decides not to select the bidder and go for re-tender, the State may explore the option of engaging NIC as the implementation agency.	
	Approval of the BPR & FRS reports submitted by SPMU	SPMU raised a concern regarding delay in approvals on BPR and FRS reports submitted to the State. State informed that the Apex Committee would be convened in June 2014 and approval would be sought during this meeting.	
	Sanction of Funds for Technical Support	State requested DeitY to sanction the funds for technical support.  It was informed that DeitY had received the letter in this regard and it has been communicated to the State that this would be placed in the next Empowered Committee meeting for approval.

	DPM Selection	It was informed that to address the attrition issue, the State should have a reserve list of candidates so that the selection process turnaround can be reduced.	
	Approval of the BPR & FRS reports submitted by SPMU	SPMU raised a concern regarding delay in approvals on BPR and FRS reports submitted to the State. The State was advised to seek Apex Committee approval at the earliest.	
	Rollout of eDistrict Services	State informed that 9 services of pilot phase would be launched across 21 districts by 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2014. In the remaining 6 scheduled area districts, the BPR report has been shared and will be finalized in

	Rollout of eDistrict Services in UTs	DeitY requested that the UT should plan to rollout eDistrict services in both UTs by the end of Mar 2015.
	Formation of DeGS	DeitY requested both the UTs to expedite formation of DeGS in the remaining 2 districts.

	Rollout of eDistrict Services	It was informed that application development by NIC has been delayed due to non-payment of advance funds to NIC.  It was suggested that a review meeting may be held with the Nodal Officer, DC- South Delhi under the chairmanship of Director (eGov) to review and resolve the project issues including pending payments to SPMU.

	Rollout of eDistrict Services	State informed that already 8 eDistrict services (overlapping with SSDG) have been launched across all the districts in the state. State informed the timelines for rollout of the remaining 51 services –  • Phase 1: 10 services by 17 <sup>th</sup> Aug 2014  • Phase 2: 25 services by 1 <sup>st</sup> Jan 2015  • Phase 3: 16 services by 19 <sup>th</sup> Mar 2015

	Rollout of eDistrict Services	Deity requested that the State should rollout all the approved eDistrict services across the State by the end of Mar 2015.
	Release of 3 <sup>rd</sup> Instalment Funds	DeitY informed the State that the funds release would be put up for approval.

	Rollout of eDistrict Services	State informed that 35 services would be launched by Nov 2014.
	Payment to SPMU	SPMU raised a concern on delays in release of their payment. State informed that payments will be released at the earliest.

	SI Selection	The State informed that it had received a single bid for SI selection and is awaiting approval from the IT Department to proceed with the bid evaluation process.
	Payment to SPMU	SPMU raised a concern on delays in release of their payment. State informed that payments will be released at the earliest.
10.	Punjab	
	Rollout of eDistrict Services	State informed that they planned to launch 47 services by 31 <sup>st</sup> Oct 2014. Considering the delays, this timeline has been revised and it is planned that 35 services will be launched by 31 <sup>st</sup> Oct 2014 (10 services by 30 <sup>th</sup> Aug 2014 and 25 services by 31 <sup>st</sup> Oct 2014). Deity requested the State to complete rollout of all 47 services by 31 <sup>st</sup> Mar 2015.
	STQC Certification of Pilot eDistrict Application	The State informed that application transition has been initiated from the pilot SI M/s HCL to M/s HP.
		STQC has completed function testing of all 47 services. Security and Performance testing is under progress. State has requested DeitY's intervention to request STQC Mohali to expedite this.
	Payment to SPMU	SPMU raised a concern that payments would get delayed due to delays of SI. DeitY requested the State to look into this matter.
