Subject: Minutes of Meeting of the eDistrict MMP National Rollout Project held on 13th October 2014 via Video Conferencing with the States/UTs

A meeting was held on 13th October 2014 to review the State readiness for the launch of eDistrict Services in the current financial year as per the RFD targets for FY14-15 and specific issues that State/UT are facing to accomplish the same. The meeting was conducted under the chairmanship of Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Joint Secretary (eGov), DeitY through Video conferencing from 4:30 pm in the Conference Room, 4th Floor, Electronics Niketan, New Delhi. The list of officials who participated in the meeting is placed at Annexure A. A copy of the presentation that was discussed during the Project Review Meeting is placed at Annexure B.

2. Joint Secretary (eGov), DeitY, welcomed all participants and discussed the current implementation status of eDistrict MMP. Joint Secretary (eGov) highlighted that the launch of eDistrict services by the States have been delayed and the States need to expedite the implementation process to meet the targets. The key decisions and actions to be taken are listed below:

		Committee. Apex Committee Meeting is scheduled in 1 st week of Nov 2014.
		 JS (eGov) suggested to complete the application development of the approved 33 services at the earliest. State has agreed the following timelines for launch of eDistrict services: Phase I: 10 services will be rolled out across all districts by 1st Feb 2015 Phase II: Remaining 23 services will be rolled out by 31st Mar 2015. State informed that around 3-4 services may be difficult to be rolled out due to approvals from respective line departments. JS (eGov) emphasized that rest of the services should be rolled out by 31st Mar 2015.
	Release of Fund	State informed that there no funds available with the State for eDistrict project. DeitY informed that the ACA funds allocated under CSC project will not be required for CSC and hence those funds can be re-allocated to eDistrict project. It was informed that necessary approval for re-allocation is being taken from IFD. In this regard, necessary orders for this re-allocation would be shared.

State has agreed to adhere to the following timelines for launch of services across all 12 non-pilot districts: 6 services will be launched by 15th November 2014 10 services will be launched by 15th March 2015
	Payments to SPMU	State informed that approvals for release of payments to SPMU are being taken up in the Apex Committee meeting scheduled on 14 th October 2014.
	Release of funds	State requested DeitY to release 2 nd instalment of ACA fund (Rs 172 Lakhs). Since there is no fund allocated by CSS in this FY 2014-15 to the State, JS (eGov) informed that this would be looked into and explore options to allocate funds to the State for this FY

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3. During the meeting, JS (eGov) emphasize to ensure the compliance of eDistrict application with the final technical architecture specified in the Integrated Framework Guidelines issued by DeitY and meeting the timelines to achieve the eDistrict services launch.

4. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to and from the Chair.


