## Subject: Minutes of Meeting of the eDistrict MMP National Rollout Project held on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2014 via Video Conferencing with the States/UTs

A meeting was held on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2014 to review the State readiness for the launch of eDistrict Services in the current financial year as per the RFD targets for FY14-15 and specific issues that State/UT are facing to accomplish the same. The meeting was conducted under the chairmanship of Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Joint Secretary (eGov), DeitY through Video conferencing from 2:30 pm in the Conference Room, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Electronics Niketan, New Delhi. The list of officials who participated in the meeting is placed at Annexure A. A copy of the presentation that was discussed during the Project Review Meeting is placed at Annexure B.

2. Joint Secretary (eGov), DeitY, welcomed all participants and discussed the current implementation status of eDistrict MMP. Joint Secretary (eGov) conveyed the broad context of the meeting by highlighting the delay in application development, selection of SI, hardware procurement etc. that have led to delays in launch of services. It was emphasized that the States need to expedite the implementation process to meet the targets. The key decisions and actions to be taken are listed below:

	SI Selection	State informed that the newly created 7 Districts have basic infrastructure and the revenue department has been requested to undertake procurement, if required, for the gap infrastructure. As of now, there is no need of Hardware RFP.
		RFP for Empanelment of vendors for Data Digitization has been issued and the empanelment is expected to be completed by 15 <sup>th</sup> November 2015.
		JS (eGov) emphasized that the eDistrict application should comply with architecture and duplication should not exist. As discussed NIC mentioned that they are working on this.
	Go-Live of Application	Services under eDistrict / ATVT application are already being provided in the 26 districts. State informed that these services also being provided in the 7 newly created districts with the existing infrastructure.
		JS (eGov) requested that the State should communicate through a letter to DeitY about the launch of services in the remaining 7 districts.
		State informed that they intend to take up a new initiative – eLocker

		(Citizen Document Repository) – creating a facility for citizens to store electronically the certificates / documents so that they need not submit physical copies while availing the government services and government departments can refer to these electronically stored documents. State sought clarification on whether this initiative can be funded under the eDistrict Scheme.
		JS (eGov) informed that additional state-level initiatives to be included in the existing Scheme, may not be appropriate, however, It was suggested State may submit a proposal for appraisal. Thereafter, DeitY would take suitable view on the same. Further it was informed that necessary technical advice may be sought from DeitY on this initiative.


