# Subject: Minutes of Meeting of the eDistrict MMP National Rollout Project held on 28th August 2014 via Video Conferencing with the States/UTs

- 1. A meeting was held on 28th August 2014 to discuss the implementation of eDistrict MMP National Rollout Project with the States/UTs having M/s PWC & M/s KPMG as their SPMU Agency. The meeting was conducted through Video conferencing from 2:30 pm in the PMU Conference Room, 4th Floor, Electronics Niketan, New Delhi. The list of officials who participated in the meeting is placed at Annexure A.
- 2. Additional Director(eGov), DeitY, welcomed all participants and discussed the current implementation status of eDistrict MMP. The key decisions and actions to be taken are listed below:
