3. The committee reviewed all the above cases in the context of D.C.T's communication No.14014//02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 30.05.2013 and recommended as below:

- (i) While going through all the above 07 cases (2 for revival and 5 existing), the committee recommended to obtain the present status of these cases in terms of their marriage, economic & dependency status before adjudging the suitability of Revival/candidature of the applicants.
- (ii) The committee also recommended to adopt an objective criteria adopted by Department of Post, Ministry of Communication & IT, in order to ensure the uniformity and objectivity for recommending the continuance/revival or dropping the name of an applicant for appointment on compassionate grounds. Committee observed that the Department of Post, under Ministry of Communications & IT has formulated some procedure for Compassionate Appointment-Relative Points and Procedure, vide Communication No.37-36/2004-SPB-1/C dated 20.01.2010, where in an objective criteria for assessing the suitability of an candidate for considering him/her for Compassionate Appointment has been adopted with the approval of Secretary (Posts). The Screening Committee recommended to adopt this criteria also in DeitY. This is also necessary to rule out any future dispute or litigation.
