Minutes of the 6th Meeting of the Empowered Committee for the National rollout of the e-District MMP, 12th November 2013.

- The 6th meeting of the Empowered Committee (EC) for the National rollout of the e-District MMP was held on 12th November at 5:30 PM in Room No 1007, Ground Floor, Electronics Niketan, 6, CGO Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi 110003.
- List of participants is at Annexure I.
- 3. Dr. Rajendra Kumar, Joint Secretary (eGov), DeitY, presented the agenda and explained the salient features of the agenda items. The agenda papers are at *Annexure II*.

AGENDA NO. 1: CONFIRMATION OF THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 20TH. FEBRUARY 2013.

 The Committee confirmed the minutes of 5th Empowered Committee meeting held on 20th February 2013.

Agenda No. 2: CURRENT IMPLEMENTATION STATUS OF EDISTRICT NATIONAL ROLL-OUT MMP

- 5. The Empowered Committee was apprised of the current implementation status of e-District National Rollout MMP. The implementation status comprising of the physical progress and the financial progress was presented as per details mentioned in the agenda papers (Annexure II).
- 6. The EC was informed that regular follow-ups have been made with the states/ UTs and the delays are being periodically highlighted to them through formal communications to the state Chief Secretaries and IT secretaries.
- Considering the current implementation status of the project, the EC expressed its concern over meeting the timelines of the project as committed by the states/UTs.
- 8. In order to expedite project implementation, the EC suggested that a deadline may be set before which the selection of SI for state-wide rollout should be completed by the state/ UT. In case, a particular state / UT does not select an SI for state-wide rollout before the set deadline, DeitY may consider withholding further release of funds to that State/UT.

AGENDA NO. 3: APPROVAL OF ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR SPMU IN THE STATES/UT OF ARUNACHAL PRADESH, DAMAN & DIU, GOA AND MANIPUR

9. The EC was informed that out of the 5 states/UTs (Arunachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar, Daman & Diu, Goa, and Lakshadweep) for which SPMU could not be appointed through DeitY's tendering process, 3 states/ UTs, viz., Arunachal Pradesh, Daman & Diu and Goa have selected their SPMU agencies.

- 10. Amongst the 29 States / UTs that were assigned SPMU agencies through DeitY's tendering process, Andhra Pradesh decided to form its State Program Management Unit through SeMT. Subsequently, Andhra Pradesh's SPMU Agency was assigned the State of Manipur.
- 11. The prices discovered by the 4 States/UTs and the additional funding required are as follows:

12. EC was informed that the prices discovered by these 4 States/UTs (Rs. 439.11 Lakhs) were not higher than those discovered through DeitY's tendering process. However, these prices discovered by the States / UTs were higher than the planned budget (Rs. 216.00 Lakhs) for SPMU in the eDistrict scheme. Accordingly, the Empowered Committee approved the additional funding (GIA) of Rs. 223.11 Lakhs for SPMUs (Rs. 83.99 Lakhs for Arunachal Pradesh, Rs. 26.66 Lakhs for Daman & Diu, Rs. 37.59 Lakhs for Goa and Rs. 74.87 Lakhs for Manipur).

AGENDA NO. 4 (a): ADDITIONAL FUNDING ON ACCOUNT OF FORMATION OF 1 NEW DISTRICT IN MADHYA PRADESH

- 14. The Committee was informed that 1 new district has been formed in Madhya Pradesh. In the 4th EC meeting, the Committee had approved the funding for additional districts created by the states/ UTs, subject to the ceiling of funding available within the scheme. The Committee was informed that the approved cost for 1 district for the State of Madhya Pradesh is Rs 243.18 lakhs (GIA 171.51 lakhs; ACA 71.67 lakhs).
- 15. The Empowered Committee approved additional funds for the state of Madhya Pradesh amounting to Rs 243.18 lakhs (GIA 171.51 lakhs; ACA 71.67 lakhs) for 1 new district.

10 States have published the RFP. All these States have all the components of the Integrated Framework for delivery of services and eDistrict model SI RFP progress. However the States which have selected NIC/Legacy SI/State agency as SI still have to communicate to DeitY on the roadmap to accomplish the same.

- Total Budget for National Rollout of eDistrict project is Rs. 1663.08 Cr (GIA Rs. 1233.08 Cr and ACA - Rs. 430.00 Cr)
- DPRs worth Rs.1605.77. (GIA -Rs. 1178.93 Cr and ACA Rs.426.84 Cr) have been approved covering 35 States / UTs for 641 districts.

AGENDA No. 3:

Approval of Additional Funding for SPMU in the States/UT of ArunachalPradesh, Daman &Diu, Goa and Manipur.

The SPMU selection was carried out by DeitY on behalf of the States and UTs to expedite the process. During the tendering process of SPMU Selection by DeitY (vide RFP No. 3(39)/2011-EG-II dated 4th Apr 2012), the L1 price had been discovered for allthe 35States/UTs.As per the process defined in the RFP, the States were allocated to the SPMU Agencies and work orders were issued to the 29 States/UTs.In its 3th Meeting on 6th July 2012, Empowered Committee had concurred allocation of the SPMU agencies for the 29 States at the price discovered through the tendering process.

Amongst these 29 States / UTs, Andhra Pradesh decided to form its State Program Management Unit through SeMT. Subsequently, Andhra Pradesh's SPMU Agency was allocated the State of Manipur.

After the due tendering process, the SPMU agencies could not be finalized for the 5 States /UTs- Arunachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar, Daman & Diu, Goa, and Lakshadweep. In case of these 5 States / UTs, it was decided that the SPMU selection should be carried out by the respective State/UT. As per the directions of DeitY, 3 of these 5 States / UTs have selected SPMU Agencies.

The price discovered by the 4 States / UTs is higher than the planned budget for SPMU in the eDistrict scheme (refer Annexure B). The table below specifies the price discovered and the additional funding required.

The total financial quote i.e. the price discovered by the 4 States/UTs is Rs. 439.11 Lakhs, which is higher than the originally provisioned amount of Rs. 216 Lakhs for SPMU in the eDistrict scheme for these 4 States / UTs. The total project cost has increased by Rs 223.11 lakh under GIA share for the States/UT of Arunachal Pradesh, Daman & Diu, Goa and Manipur.

APPROVAL SOUGHT:

The Empowered Committee may approve the additional funding of Rs. 223.11 Lakhs for SPMU (Rs. 83.99 Lakhs for Arunachal Pradesh, Rs. 26.66 Lakhs for Daman & Diu, Rs.37.59 Lakhs for Goa and Rs.74.87 Lakhs for Manipur).

AGENDA No. 4 (a):

Additional funding on account of formation of 1 new district in Madhya Pradesh

The DPR for Madhya Pradesh was approved in the 3rdEC Meeting held on 6th July 2012 in which a total amount of Rs. 11502.88 lakhs (GIA - Rs. 8277.88 lakhs; ACA - Rs. 3225.00 lakhs) was approved for 45 districts. In the 4th EC meeting, the Committee had expressed the view

that since e-District National Rollout scheme is citizen centric in design / approach, it is envisaged that all the districts in the State should provide services through this Scheme. It was decided that to incorporate demands for funds for newly created administrative units, it is proposed that the States / UTs, who's DPRs are already approved, will be requested to submit the details of newly formed administrative units at the earliest. The Empowered Committee had approved the funding of additional Districts created by the States / UTs, subject to the ceiling of funding available within the Scheme.

Now, the State of Madhya Pradesh has communicated formation of 1 new district (Agar-Malwa) vide letter no: 165/2013/SAPS/2013 dated 23.09.2013 (Annexure C). The approved cost for 1 district for the State of Madhya Pradesh is Rs 243.18 lakhs (GIA – 171.51 lakhs; ACA – 71.67 lakhs).

APPROVAL SOUGHT

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Based on the above, the Empowered Committee may approve additional funds for the State of Madhya Pradesh amounting to Rs 243.18 lakhs (GIA - 171.51 lakhs; ACA - 71.67 lakhs) for 1 new district.

AGENDA No. 4 (b):

Additional funding on account of formation of 7 new districts in Gujarat

The DPR for Gujarat was approved in the 2ndEC Meeting held on 29th March 2012 in which a total amount of Rs.6877.87 lakhs (GIA – 5014.54 lakhs; ACA – 1863.33 lakhs) was approved for 26 districts. In the 4th EC meeting, the Committee had expressed the view that since e-District National Rollout scheme is citizen centric in design / approach, it is envisaged that all the districts in the State should provide services through this Scheme. It was decided that to incorporate demands for funds for newly created administrative units, it is proposed that the States / UTs, who's DPRs are already approved, will be requested to submit the details of newly formed administrative units at the earliest. The Empowered Committee had approved the funding of additional Districts created by the States / UTs, subject to the ceiling of funding available within the Scheme.

Now, the State of Gujarat has communicated formation of 7 new districts (Arvalli, GirSomnath,

Botad, Chhotaudepur, Mahisagar, Morbi, DevbhumiDwarka) vide letter N0:GOI/10/2013/431551/Part-1/IT dated 25th October 2013 (Annexure D). The approved cost for Idistrict for the State of Gujarat is Rs 243.18 lakhs (GIA – Rs. 171.51 lakhs; ACA – Rs. 71.67 lakhs). The additional cost for 7 districts would be Rs 1702.26 lakhs (GIA – Rs.1200.57lakhs; ACA – Rs 501.69)

APPROVAL SOUGHT

Based on the above, the Empowered Committee may approve additional funds for the State of Gujarat amounting to Rs 1702.26 lakhs (GIA - 1200.57 lakhs; ACA - 501.69 lakhs) for 7 new districts.

AGENDA No 5:

Presentation from the States on progress of nationwide implementation eDistrict project
