Major achievements Month of August, 2019

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of August, 2019 are as given below:

I. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month:

i) Aadhaar

A delegation of Permanent Representatives of different countries in United Nations visited UIDAI Headquarters on 19th August 2019. A presentation on Aadhaar was given to the visiting delegation, followed by a question-answer session.

ii) International Cooperation

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed between Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) of the Republic of India and The Republic of Estonia on 21st August 2019 in Estonia to enhance cooperation in e-Governance, emerging Digital Technologies especially artificial intelligence, machine learning, data analytics, robotics, visual data processing, virtual reality etc. It will also leverage HRD or training of officials through joint training programmes between officials, faculty and through student exchange. The MoU also proposed cooperation in the area of cyber security and exploring the cyber security cooperation mechanism between CERT-IN and CERT-EE.

Important developments under MeitY's Schemes:

- As on 31st August, 2019, total number of Aadhaar generated (Live) are 120.75 crore against the 'projected population 2019' of 135.39 crore. Aadhaar saturation (Projected Population 2019) across India stands at 89.19%.
- Total number of e-Services registered in eTaal till 31st August, 2019 is 3,735.

The number of Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) generated till August, 2019 is 261.43 lakh and number of DLCs generated in the month of August, 2019 is 76,505.

MyGov

MyGov has 810 discussion themes and 843 tasks. Around 94.16 lakh people have registered on the Platform and each one is receiving weekly newsletter.

ePDS

Till the month of August 2019, National Food Security Act (NFSA), 2013 has been adopted by all 36 States/ UTs. Almost 100% digitisation of Ration Cards (RCs) has been achieved, as 23.40 crore Ration Cards (RCs) have been digitized. Out of the total 5.35 lakh Fair Price Shops (FPS) in the country, around 77.06%, i.e. 4.12 lakhs FPS have been automated.

Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India

Around 3.13 lakh resources have been contributed under 7,657 catalogs and 1,828 Visualizations and 14,900 APIs have been created.
