Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology Major Achievements for the Month of July 2019

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of July, 2019 are as given below:

I. Important Policy decisions taken and major achievements during the month :

1) <u>Aadhaar</u>

The Aadhaar and Other Laws (Amendment) Act, 2019 of Parliament received the assent of the President on 23rd July 2019 and was published in the Gazette of India on 24th July 2019. The provisions of the said Act came into force w.e.f. 25th July 2019 by way of Notification published in the Gazette of India.

A workshop at Hyderabad was conducted on "Aadhaar Offline Applications and Services" explaining Aadhaar Offline Verification, Aadhaar Paperless Offline, e-KYC and Secure QR Code and live demo of applications and services was given to 100 participants from various Insurance Companies.

A delegation from Guinea visited UIDAI Headquarters on 12th July 2019. A presentation on Aadhaar followed by question-answer session was given to the visiting delegation.

The number of Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) generated till July, 2019 is 260 lakh and number of DLCs generated in the month of July, 2019 is 1.38 lakh.

MyGov

MyGov has 64 groups, 807 discussion themes, 822 tasks and 586 blogs. Around 82.90 lakh people have registered on the Platform and each one is receiving weekly newsletter.

ePDS

Till the month of July 2019, National Food Security Act (NFSA), 2013 has been adopted by all 36 States/ UTs. Almost 100% digitisation of Ration Cards (RCs) has been achieved, as 23.21 crore Ration Cards (RCs) have been digitized. Out of the total 5.34 lakh Fair Price Shops (FPS) in the country, around 77.04%, i.e. 4.12 lakhs FPS have been automated.

Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India

Around 3.01 lakh resources have been contributed under 7,593 catalogs and 1,790 Visualizations and 13,362 APIs have been created.
